- We represented a client in a claim involving a defectively designed and constructed 700,000-square-foot shelter roof. Our
 litigation team, with the help of technical consultants, determined the cause of the roof failures and then pursued claims
 against multiple parties involved in the construction project, positioning them for an early resolution. Upon initiation of
 the claims, our attorneys engaged all counsel involved on behalf of the parties, where a mediation resulted in the
