ACTIVITIES & HONORS

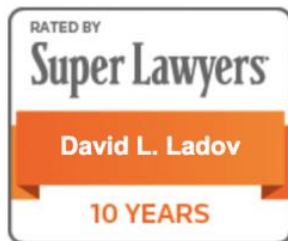
