Tom is the President of the Pennsylvania Chapter Irish American Partnership and Member of National Board of Directors.

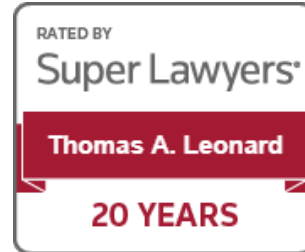
